Best Rider (Combination) ranking is calculated by adding up points received in the two Qualifiers (at Stage I and Stage II) and Final competition. To receive the title of best rider, the rider must have participated in at least one of the qualifiers (07 02-04 or 08 06-08).

GENERAL RULES:

- In the competitions points are given according to points table below, based on number of participants that collect points.
- For qualifying competitions 1x coefficient will be applied, for the Final 2x coefficient will be applied.
- **Best Rider (Combination) ranking is calculated by adding up points received in the two Qualifiers (at Stage I and Stage II) and Final competition.**
- In case of equal results for the title of Best Rider, the winner will be the rider who placed higher in the Final competition. In case there is still equality, the rider who place higher in Qualifier in the II stage.
- In each stage, rider can collect points with particular horse in one Challenge. The rider can collect points in different Challenges with different horses at the same stage.
- In one stage, only one rider can collect points in one Challenge with particular horse.
- Same rider can collect points and fight for Best Rider title in different Challenges. However, with the same horse, in one stage, the rider can only collect points in one Challenge.
- Challenge horse must be in startlist before other horses of the same rider. Rider can select their Challenge horse in the entry form before show.
- Once competition in question has started, Challenge horse cannot be changed. If there is less than 1 hour until the start of the competition in question left, Challenge horse can only be changed if the previous Challenge horse is withdrawn, the new Challenge horse will have the same starting number as the withdrawn horse.
- In different stages rider can collect Challenge points with different horses.
- In case rider didn't select his Challenge horse in the entry form, the horse that starts first in the startlist will be counted as Challenge horse.
- In the Final, rider can participate with any horse, doesn't matter whether the horse participated in any of the stages or not. (Except in Young Horses Challenge)
- In case where multiple riders collected points with the same horse in different stages, in the Final only one rider can collect points with this horse and fight for Best Rider title.
- To receive the title of best rider, the rider must have participated in at least one of the qualifiers (07 02-04 or 08 06-08).

YOUNG HORSES CHALLENGE:

- In the Young Horses Challenge rider can collect points with 2 horses at the same stage.

Standard bedding upon arrival is free of charge. In case Athlete would like to pre-order shavings, hay or other items to be delivered to the boxes, it is possible to do so by leaving a comment in Equipe Entry system.

5. PRIZE GIVING CEREMONY

The number of athletes required to present themselves for the prize giving ceremony of each competition is 5. Organiser keeps right to reduce prizes in case there are less than 10 competitors in the competition.

All prize giving ceremonies must strictly follow the Covid-19 guidelines for Prize giving protocols and media activities.

VI. VETERINARY MATTERS

GENERAL

In accordance with the FEI Code of Conduct for the Welfare of the Horse it is imperative that all Horses are physically fit and free from infectious disease before being allowed to compete.

PASSPORTS AND LICENSES

All horses competing in competitions must have a valid passport (National or FEI Passport / FEI Recognition card). Lithuanian riders and their horses must be registered with Lithuanian Equestrian Federation and have valid licenses to participate in the event. Riders and horses that only participate in P level are not required to have licenses

VACCINATION AND BLOOD TEST

Flu vaccination should be valid in accordance with Lithuanian veterinarian requirements (according to manufacturer requirements, once a year). Blood test according Lithuanian State food and veterinary Service requirements, horse blood should be tested against 3 diseases (Equine infectious anaemia, Dourine, Glanders) once per year.

As an Athlete/Owner you are personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by you, your employees, Support Personnel, your agents or your Horses. You are, therefore, strongly advised to take out third-party liability insurance

providing full coverage in relation to Events at home and abroad, and to keep the policy up to date. The Organiser will NOT be responsible for any damage caused to third parties by you, your employees, Support Personnel, your agents or your Horses.

5. BEHAVIOUR AT THE EVENT

The Organizer will not accept sales or offers to sell hay, shavings, straw, feeds, riding equipment or any other items by any other suppliers in the show ground during the show. For any illegal sales, a fine of 100 EUR per offence will be charged. Repeating offence at the Event may lead to exclusion from the Venue. Motors, quads etc. are not allowed in the stable and competition areas.

If allowed at the Event, all dogs must be leashed and affixed to a human or stationary object. Violation of this rule will incur a fine of 80 EUR per offence and, in case of a repeated offence at the Event, may lead to exclusion from the Venue.

6. PROTECTION OF PERSONAL DATA

PHOTOS AND VIDEOS

By making an entry to the Event Athlete consents to being photographed and/or video recorded by the official Photo/Video team of the Event. Photographs and/or video recordings including images of Athlete, can be used both internally and externally to promote the Event. These images could be used in print and digital media formats including but not limited to print publications, websites, e-marketing, posters, banners, advertising and social media purposes.

PERSONAL INFORMATION

The company responsible for maintaining entries website entry.equipe.com is as well responsible for the storage and protection of data. Startlists and Results at online.equipe.com will include same information as requested on the entry. However, age of the Athlete, contact details, address and company details will be excluded.

During the Event official Announcer will use First Name and Last Name of Athlete, Horse details including first and last name of the Owner, results and rankings as well as previous accomplishments in Equestrian Sports. You have right to disagree to provide personal information requested in the Schedule. However, if you disagree to provide requested information the Entry will be declined.

7. PRIZE MONEY

For permanent residents of Lithuania, all prizes above 200 EUR are subject to Lithuanian Income Tax - 15%. Prizes received by non-residents are not a subject to Lithuanian Income Tax. All fees and extra costs have to be paid before the departure. All prizes will be paid by Bank Transfer within ten (10) days after the last Competition of the Event provided the Athlete have met all his/her financial and other obligations to the OC.

All Athletes, that won any amount of prize money in addition to accreditation forms, will be asked to fill special tax form that will include necessary details, such as residence address, bank account to which prize money should be paid and etc.
